

To whom it may concern

I am a Sports Rifle Target shooter and require a single focal lens, for my dominant eye, to place in a set of single-lens shooting glasses or eyecup ofmm Diameter ideally with a marker line indicating the top centre, but not essential.

The focal length I wish to achieve is 2metres, which I understand to be +0.5. The accepted and taught technique is to have the foresight in sharp focus, it's the bit we move and control to achieve the good shot, the aiming mark is fixed, and we judge the white gap in the foresight around the aiming mark, as long as we have a good enough "view" of that aiming mark and we see it as a round space, we can achieve a perfect aim.

The lens, therefore, is required to be +0.5 over my prescription (eg -1.50 shooting prescription is -1.00 and +1.50 shooting prescription is +2.00)
